

Cedar Lake Camp



From Los Angeles / Orange Counties to Cedar Lake Camp

1100 Mill Creek Road Big Bear Lake, CA. 92315

GPS lat. N 34° 13' 49.9" long. W 116° 56' 19.6"

Take I-10 East to the Running Springs Hwy 210 exit in Redlands.
Follow Hwy 210 to Hwy 330 to Hwy 18.

At the Big Bear Lake dam, make a right turn and pass over the dam itself. After passing Boulder and Metcalf Bays on your left, you'll pass the Town Hall /Performing Arts Center on the right. About $\frac{1}{5}$ miles further, make a right turn onto Tulip Lane.

About $\frac{1}{4}$ mile further, past the closed USFS campground on your right, turn right onto Mill Creek Road. (Oak Knoll Lodge is on your left) Come 1 mile into camp. When the pavement ends, stay to your right and welcome to Cedar Lake Camp.
